Dr. Bauer's research covers a wide range of issues related to the evolution of communications and information industries, in particular the design and effect of public policies towards next-generation networks and services, Internet governance, and mobile communications. He also researches business strategies, often from a comparative and international perspective. Recent projects have been funded by the National Science Foundation, the Ford Foundation, the Humboldt Foundation, the OECD, and the International Telecommunication Union.

Professor Bauer is a frequent speaker at international conferences and has served as an advisor for public and private sector organizations in North and South America, Europe, and Asia. In addition to serving on the Boards of the International Telecommunications Society and the Telecommunications Policy Research Conference. Dr. Bauer joined Michigan State University in 1990. He received his doctorate in economics from the Vienna University of Economics and Business Administration, Vienna, Austria.
